



CYIA® Student Staff Guide

Please note that this guide is a supplement to the CYIA Student Guide. As Student Staff, you will find that this Guide gives you greater freedoms and greater responsibilities than you had as a student.



Where and when does this training begin?

You are expected to be on campus Saturday and be moved in by 4:00pm. There will be an orientation meeting after the 5:00 evening meal.

The cost of training for Student Staff is **\$100.00** is to be sent with the application (a check made payable to "CEF of MI"). If this creates a hardship for you please call me at 269-277-2938.



What is the schedule during training?

Because you are in a position of leadership, your daily quiet time is of even greater necessity than that of the students, and you may find it necessary to have your quiet time before "rise and shine" at 6:30. You will assist the Dean of Men or Women with the "rise and shine" at 6:30 a.m. and lights out at 10:00 p.m. (for the students). Lights out for Student Staff is 11:00 p.m.



What should or should not be brought to the training?

See CYIA Student Guide with the following exceptions:

You may bring a cell phone. This is to facilitate communication with other staff. Personal use should be minimal, and every effort should be made to limit such use of your cell phone to designated free times. Other students are not to use your cell phone.

You may bring a laptop computer but you may not keep it in your room. It may be used in the staff room for those things considered part of preparation for CYIA. It may not be used to for watching movies, playing computer games etc.

As with the students, this is a unique environment to concentrate on developing yourself for serving the Lord. Bring items that will help you and leave home those items that may hinder.



What is the dress code?

Student Staff are expected to dress and abide by the staff dress code:

Ladies: Business casual, dress slacks, skirts, dresses, blouses

Guys: Docker style slacks, dress slacks, collared shirts, polo shirts – ties optional



With the exception of cell phone usage, which was discussed above, the remainder of the CYIA Student Guide applies equally to Student Staff.



What is expected of Student Staff during the training?

In addition to what has been mentioned, Student Staff are expected to set an example for the students to follow. This includes prompt and faithful attendance at all teaching sessions and staff meetings, as well as careful adherence to the Student Staff Guide.
